A resolution naming the Airport the "Washington Island Airport" was made and the following Resolution and Agency Agreement was signed, and ~~the~~ the following airport resolution was made. Whereas: In order that the Town of Washington can participate in the State and Federal aid Airport program it is necessary that the Town of Washington have the sum of \$6375 six thousand three hundred seventy five dollars in its 1948 budget for Airport improvement. Whereas the Town of Washington has at the present time seven thousand (7000) dollars in U.S. Government bonds that could be used in the Airport budget. Therefore it resolved that the Town Board of Town of Washington transfer sufficient bonds to the Airport budget to make the amount of six thousand three hundred seventy five (\$6375) dollars. This money to be used to match State + Federal aid for the Washington Island Airport at Washington Island, Wis.

This resolution to be put on a referendum ballot and presented to voters of the Town of Washington on April 1948.

The Town Board met at the Town Clerk's office at 8 o'clock P.M. Conrad Anderson and Wm Jacobson were present.

The report of the appraisers Robert W. Gunnerson and Nels C. Nelson was read and delivered to the Attorney Thorval T. Loft, the value set by the appraisers was Paul #2 Carl Schaub \$2298.00 C.O. Hansen Paul #3 was \$7485.00, Arnold Klingenberg Paul #4 was \$981.75 and Edward Anderson Paul #5 was \$2251.50, the price asked was Carl Schaub 2700.00 but only allowed to pay \$2500.00 C.O. Hansen asking 8000.00 Arnold Klingenberg asking \$1000.00 and Edward Anderson \$2251.50, which makes a total of \$13,751.50 or \$1,751.50 more than the \$12,000.00 estimated cost, which was proposed to be raised as follows, Federal Government \$438.00 State of Wisconsin \$657.00 and Town of Washington \$657.00

therefor the following resolution was passed
 Whereas: It is necessary to appropriate and
 additional \$657.00 for Airport purposes.
 Therefore, Be it resolved that the Town Clerk
 be instructed to transfer \$657.00 from
 the Highway fund to the Airport fund
 and that the \$657.00 will be added
 to the 1948 tax roll to reimburse the
 highway fund, a copy of this resolution
 will be sent to the State Aeronautics
 Commission.

The Town Clerk was instructed to cash the
 remaining three - \$1000 coupon bonds.
 At 10 o'clock a motion was made and
 carried to adjourn.
